Peru rescinds new rule requiring Mexican nationals to obtain a visa prior to entry

Executive summary

On 11 April 2024, the Peruvian government passed Decree No. 012-2024-RE (“the Decree”) which states that Mexican nationals will not be required to obtain a visa prior to admission into the country.

Key developments

This follows the [announcement](#) on 8 April 2024 that Mexican nationals would require an entry visa to be admitted to Peru as of 23 April 2024. As a result of the Decree, Mexican nationals may continue to enter Peru using only their valid passports (without a visa) for business and tourism for up to 180 days per calendar year.

Impact on employers

The Decree is expected to mitigate potential business disruptions that were anticipated following the previous announcement that Mexican nationals would require a visa to enter the country.
